Products affected: Small lift silencers of various types and sizes

Summary

Halyard is introducing a revised production process to achieve an improved visual appearance, combined with improved temperature and pressure capabilities.

Timing

This change will be applied to small lift silencers, particularly those with higher sales volumes, progressively from Summer 2010.

Background

Smaller lift silencers are hand-laminated with traces of GRP mat visible on the lid and and overlap to the tubular body. This gives enormous strength and a temperature ability which far outweighs that of plastic or polypropylene silencers. Equally we have had requests for an improved appearance and have therefore invested in mould tooling which gives a smooth finish while retaining and improving the pressure containment and temperature tolerance of the product.
